In particular, I will conduct research into alternative compositional forms that complicate the Western patriarchal five-paragraph essay and honor multicultural modes of writing. I will read current scholarship and interview experts in order to gather more equitable models and assignments for composition. The outcomes will be improved instruction and student success, especially for our students of color. Achievement will be measured through the creation of model essay and assignment banks, composition of my own essays, presentations to faculty, and academic publication of my findings. Ultimately, the Grossmont students, English Department, College, District, and community will benefit from these more equitable practices.
