The race/ethnicities most represented by students enrolled in FA24 are Hispanic/Latinx at 38% and White at 25.3%.

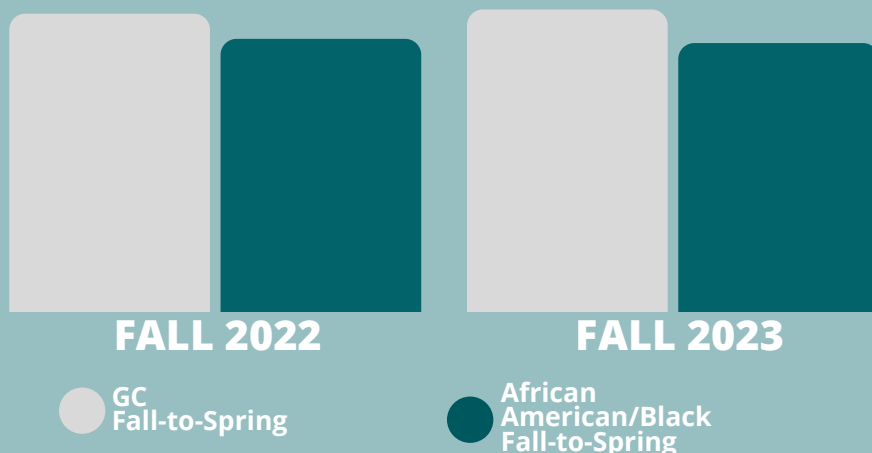

PERSISTENCE RATE

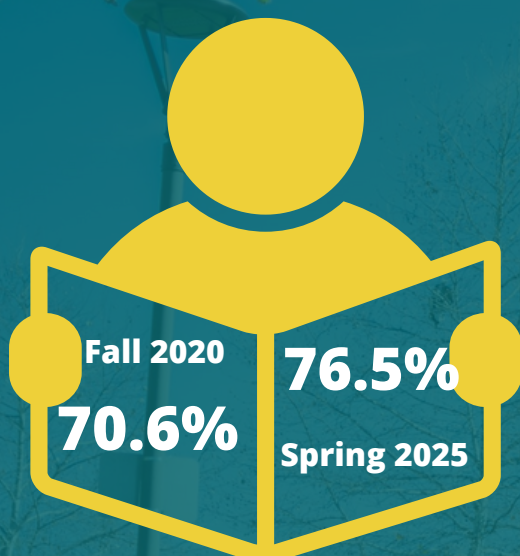
African American & Black student persistence rates are consistently lower than overall Grossmont rates.
