V. Chair Report

a) Board Presentation, 12/16/2026

- Board Packet was approved. There was some pushback from the board about curriculum change to ENGL C1001 that was flagged for SAAM. They were teaching lab and lecture in a way that was not equivalent to units. A five-page report was submitted prior to board members. More direct communication was needed.

b) Special Topics Proposals

- Some courses are experimental; are offered but not approved-can run up to four times. These courses are in Colleague and COCI but are not official or put in the catalog. Cuyamaca stopped doing these about 10 years ago. For Grossmont it is a lot of work in IOPS to push thru a 299 class than to push through an official course. We may decide to remove this as a committee.

c) Phase III – CCN

- We were set to receive the templates but that has been delayed. The phase I and II did not have guaranteed articulation, phase II should for CSU and UC. Grossmont is slated to have 45 courses slated for phase III. Hopefully in March we will find out which ones. There may be some issues with Biology and Chemistry prereqs.

d) Curriculum Institute

- Will take place third week of July Weds-Sat in Sacramento. There will be online and in-person options. Requests should be done three months in advance.

VI. Articulation Report-

1. CCN Phase II and III

- All of the ADTs are submitted that have CCN impacts, with the exception of the ones still in review. Some new templates are being released

2. ADTs

- Just minor updates: Will be submitting some for program modification in the next cycle. Chemistry was approved to have 66 units, so we can now offer a Chemistry ADT.
