Student Centered Funding Formula (SCFF) Components

Base Allocation

FTES Base, with Credit FTES calculated on a 3-year average. Rates vary depending on FTES type. Base also includes the basic allocation for the size and number of colleges, and number/type of education centers.

Access

Student Equity Allocation

Based on prior year headcounts of low-income students served in following categories: (1) Pell Grant recipients, (2) all College Promise Grant recipients, and (3) AB 540 students.





Student Success Allocation

Based on three yr. average of the number of students meeting a more broadly-defined set of success outcomes. Rates and point values vary depending on success metric

Supplemental Allocation Components

For the supplemental allocation, a district would receive one "point" based on the actual number of students served in the <u>prior year</u> within each of the three areas below:

Pell Grant recipients.

Headcount of students who received a Federal Pell Grant in the district in the reporting year

California College Promise Grant recipients (BOG fee waiver recipients).

Headcount of students who received a California College Promise Grant fee waiver pursuant to ECS 76300 in the district in the reporting year

AB 540 students.

Headcount of students by district who were granted an exemption from nonresident tuition pursuant to ECS 68130.5 in the district in the reporting year

Associate Degrees

Three-year average headcount of students by district who were reported as receiving a Chancellor's Office approved associate degree at the district in the reporting year and were reported with an enrollment at the district in the reporting year and did not meet the criteria for the SCFF Associate Degree for Transfer (ADT) metric. Can only count highest award

Student Success Allocation Components

Credit Certificates (16 units or more)

Three-year average headcount of students by district who were reported as receiving a Chancellor's Office approved credit certificate requiring the equivalent of 16 or more semester units at the district in the reporting year and were reported with an enrollment at the district in the reporting year. Can only count highest award

Baccalaureate Degrees

Three-year average headcount of students by district who were reported as receiving a Chancellor's Office approved baccalaureate degree at the district in the reporting year and were reported with an enrollment at the district in the reporting year. Can only count highest award.

Completion of Transfer-level Mathematics and English Course within First Academic Year of Enrollment

Three-year average headcount of students by district who successfully completed both a transfer level mathematics course and a transfer-level English course with grades equivalent to C or better in the district during the academic year when first reported as non-special admit credit student.

Student Success Allocation Components

Successful Transfer to Four-Year University

Three-year average headcount of students by district who earned the equivalent of 12 or more semester units in the district in the year prior to the reporting year and were not reported as enrolled at a California Community College in the reporting year and were reported as enrolled at a 4-year institution in the reporting year. Direct match with CSU, UC and Clearinghouse.

Completion of Nine or More CTE Units

Three-year average headcount of students by district who successfully completed the equivalent of nine or more CTE units with grades equivalent to C or better within the district in the reporting year

Attainment of Regional Living Wage

Three-year average headcount of students by district who were enrolled in the district in the year prior to the reporting year, were not enrolled system-wide or at any transfer institution in the reporting year and were reported as earning wages greater than or equal to the regional living wage for the district in the reporting year.
