The top 5 PD topics for 2024 are: 1. Leadership Development (46) 2. Culturally responsive pedagogy & practices 3. Resources available for students 4. Addressing implicit bias/micro-aggressions 5. Self-care/work-life balance 6. Data access, reporting and/or usage Graylin suggested the ACCCA "How to be an Administrator" programs to help build leadership skills and networking. Karen Hern mentioned that she might be able to get some volunteers to do a "How to be a Chair" workshop or something like that. Common barriers include timing/schedule. It was agreed to do the assessment again and share the results of the past two
