We meet students where they are at...

- We offer in-person and Zoom appointments, and talk with students over the phone as well
- Appointments are available MF throughout business hours and make information available online and on Canvas 24/7 (evening appointments were offered through Fall 2024 accommodating working/parent schedules)
- We utilize eCounseling to provide answers to quick questions
- We provide information in multiple formats to communicate important reminders of transfer-related deadlines and upcoming events
 - Formats include: announcements via Canvas, appointments, emails to faculty, fliers posted on campus, inperson resource library, social media, UC TAP communications, website, workshops...

We unravel the complexities of transfer...

- Through communications, training, presentations at meetings throughout our division, workshops and appointments.
- - SB 1440: ADTs resulting in multiple pathways to SDSU, UC*, etc.
 - AB 132: Dual Admission
 - AB 928: Single GE and Auto-Enroll ADT
 - AB 1111: Common Course Numbering
 - AB 1291: UCLA to pilot ADT Transfer Program


And technical support needed for applications, Grossmont College processes, setting up SDSU email, etc.

*While UCs do not currently use ADTs for admission, they created Transfer Pathways and Pathways+



• We advocate...

For all of our students!

- Work with colleagues to advocate against implementation of AB 1705 effectively eliminating Math 170, 175 and 176 from our course offerings
 - Collaborate with Region X TCD in an effort to change the UCSD Ulink eligibility criteria (currently \$40,000 or less income and 3.5+ GPA)
 - ADT Paper Verification: collaborated with SDSU and Evaluations on 38 ADT paper verifications, 36 of the students were admitted to SDSU and/or CSUSM—would not have been admitted without ADT verified
 - Liberal Studies and SDSU (non-locals admitted over locals)

We provide transfer support from beginning to end...

- Workshops to inform students of transfer options: Transfer 101 (Highlights CCC to HBCU guarantee), ADT, SDSU Transfer Pathways
 - Application Support: HBCU, Common Black College Application, Cal State Apply, UC Application, Common App
 - We maintain Canvas containers for CSU and UC application support accessible 24/7
 - We participate in campuswide events: Success Fairs, WoW Week, Family Nights, Career/Re-entry Orientation, Grad Info Session...




