10. Update from SEP Workgroup	V. Rodriguez shared that the SEP Workgroup is breaking up into teams by metric. A survey is being developed to get feedback from disproportionately impacted student populations on campus. Faculty and classified staff will distribute the survey to make sure

	these populations are reached. Responses will be collected before the spring 2025 semester ends. Information from the survey will be used to help strategize on how to fill equity gaps at Grossmont. The workgroups will keep working over the summer at scheduled retreats. Participants should responded to survey on potential meeting dates which will be shared in the near future.
