**A. Drafting Amendment to ASGC Constitution**

The Ad Hoc Committee will discuss changes to the ASGC Constitution and take action on finalizing the amendment

The Constitution will revert to the Constitution of August 8, 2019, but not limited to;

Reverting all titles: Publicity, Campus Activities, Student Legislation, VP of Finance. As for the secretary role, we will revert it back to Director of Board Affairs. The Internal Ad hoc committees will still be there but will be optional to each director and by necessity. The committee will keep the veto of the President. Regarding the ICC (Interclub Council), the power will return to the Executive Vice President, and they shall serve all the President and Chair of the ICC. Constitution, it is illegal to implement them to be a California resident. Section B. Election Committee; we will remove an ASGC member from being able to be included into the committee as it can cause conflict of interests and cause difficulties. It will remain under Student Affairs. The committee will not be keeping the current Impeachment and discipline. How we have done things before the new changes is how we will continue doing it from now forward.

The Ad Hoc Committee will discuss changes to the ASGC Bylaws and take action on finalizing the amendment

The Bylaws will revert to the Bylaws of August 8, 2019, but not limited to; Article 8 Section B1, while removing section B2, President \$350 to \$400, VP \$275 to \$300, VP Finance \$275 to \$300, and will not add back in the 25% deduction clause, it will all be taken care of with disciplinary action. Will remove California Residency requirement and ASGC Rep from the Election Committee. There will be explicit information regarding the roles of directors within the election, and within the constitution/bylaws and to not having one position to have much power.
