Documented satisfactory completion of 2 or more years of formal schooling at the 6th grade level or higher in an institution where the language of instruction is not English. All courses on IGETC must be completed with a grade of "C" or better. Grades of "C-" are not acceptable. Each course acceptable for IGETC must have a minimum 3 semester or 4 quarter unit value. Students wishing to use a course to meet an IGETC requirement must be sure that the course is on the approved IGETC list during the academic year when it is taken.

- \*UC credit may be limited. (1) No credit given for an introductory course if taken after more advanced college course, (2) credit may be limited for courses with overlapping content, (3) duplicate credit will not be awarded for both the Honors and regular version of a course.
- \*\*Courses taken at regionally accredited colleges or universities that are not part of the California Community College system can meet general education requirements for IGETC. Approval of IGETC placement is done by the Articulation Officer, M. Denise Aceves, via the "Pass Along" review process
